Approval of Minutes – December 21, 2022 Meeting

Unfinished Business

1. MDOT Village Partnership Initiative (VPI)
  - Use of ARPA funds for initiative were approved by the Select Board last June.
  - Bruce forwarded the overview to the Town Manager.
  - Follow-up with Town Manager on next steps.
2. Slowing Down Motor Vehicle Traffic
  - LAB National Promotion
  - Charley proposed that the Ogunquit speed limit should be lowered to 25 mph town wide. Today the speed limit is 30 mph on North Village Road, and 35 mph on Route 1 north of Scotch Hill, otherwise 25 mph.
  - Need input from Chief Lizanecz.
3. League of American Bicyclists – Bike Friendly Community Application
  - Next cycle application is due in February which may be difficult to meet.
4. Obed's Lane Concern
  - Pedestrian safety concern on busy cut-through street with no sidewalk. Obed's Lane narrows and has limited line-of-sight visibility with a curve and hill at Main Street making for a dangerous situation.

- Tom Torno and crew have started clearing Town owned property on the north side of Obed's Lane in preparation for building the sidewalk.
  - Tom Torno is adding to his proposed FY'24 funding to construct the actual sidewalk and a sidewalk on Berwick Road from South Street to Spring Hill Road. Funding would need to be approved in the June 2023 warrant before construction could be completed.
  - The Town Manager is investigating possible Federal funding for the sidewalks.
  - Chief Lizanecz to review Obed's Lane blind speed study.
  - The Chief will check with Jim Tassé on recommended signage that could be utilized until the sidewalk is completed.
5. Speed of Wheeled Vehicles in Bike Lanes and Sidewalks
    - eBikes, electric Scooters, Onewheels, electric skateboards, hoverboards.
    - Foreign worker education. Should connect with Chamber to see what is planned for 2023.
  6. OPD Distribution of Bike Lights and Reflective Bands
    - Discuss at next meeting with Chief Lizanecz.
  7. Complete Streets Policy
    - Approved by Select Board 2/4/2020.
    - Charley to follow-up with the Town Manager.
  8. Berwick Road Sidewalk -- Tracking
    - Sidewalk between South Street and Spring Hill Road
  9. New RRFB on Main Street at Panache -- Tracking
    - Bike Maine researched subject with Maine DOT and is still waiting for parts.
  10. LED Lighting - Tracking
    - Installation of LED streetlights on Main Street should now be complete. Need to check previously defined crosswalks.
