Unfinished Business

1. Slowing Down Motor Vehicle Traffic
 - Focus on the first priority to reduce the speed on North Village Road to 25 mph.
 - Speed sign boards are up on North Village Road.
 - Town Manager not in favor of applying to Maine DOT for further reduction of speed limit on North Village Road because it traverses three towns.
2. League of American Bicyclists – Bike Friendly Community Application
 - Bruce and Michele to work on in November. Next application cycle due June 2024.
3. Bike Rack Locations
 - Paul to evaluate bike occupancy at the beaches on peak days this summer.
 - Marjorie to assist Paul in evaluating bicycle rack needs.
 - Determine if additional bike racks are needed or need to be relocated.
 - Committee requested funding for one additional bike rack in FY25 budget.

4. Speed of eBikes and Micro Mobility Vehicles in Bike Lanes and Sidewalks
5. New RRFBs on Main Street at Panache and north end of Glen Ave
 - Positive citizen feedback.
